

FACTS**WHAT DOES *INNOVATIVE FUNDING SERVICES DBA TRESL* DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and Income
- Account Balance and Payment History
- Credit History and Credit Scores

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Innovative Funding Services DBA Tresl chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Innovative Funding Services DBA Tresl protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does Innovative Funding Services DBA Tresl collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Apply for a loan or give us your income information
- show your driver's license or give us your contact information
- Provide employment information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.

- *Our affiliates include companies sharing common ownership including; Tresl, Hourglass Management, Flexco Fleet Services, E Fleet Direct, and those with the Innovative Funding Services Name.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *nonaffiliates we can share with include companies such as lenders and automotive after market product companies.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Our joint marketing partners include companies such as insurance companies and lenders.*

Other Important Information

California Residents: Accounts with a California mailing address are automatically treated as if they have limited the sharing with nonaffiliates as described above. California residents are also provided a California Privacy Notice.

Nevada Residents: This notice is being provided to you pursuant to Nevada law. If you prefer not to receive marketing calls from us, you may be placed on our Internal Do Not Call List by calling 1-866-504-3748, or by writing to us at 1706 E New Hope Drive, Suite 1A Leander, Texas 78641. Vermont Residents: Non-public personal financial information may not be shared with others, except as permitted by law, unless the Vermont consumer specifically consents to the disclosure. In addition, Vermont law prohibits the sharing of credit reports and/or creditworthiness information with affiliates, except as permitted by law, unless the consumer has consented to ("opted-in") to such sharing. For joint marketing, we will only disclose your name, contact information and information about your transactions.
